Howard Iceberg is donating a CD's worth of tunes to benefit a fellow musician

Dozens of her friends and colleagues in the local music scene are coming to the aid of Abigail Henderson, and one of them is offering something extra.

Songwriter Howard Iceberg, commander of the Titanics, is also donating a CD's worth of original music called "November Night." And one of those songs ought to surprise even his most loyal fans.

Fifty copies of "November Nights" will be available at shows Saturday at Davey's Uptown and Sunday at the RecordBar. Those shows are part of "[Apocalypse Meow](#)," a benefit for Henderson of the band The Gaslights. She is undergoing treatment for inflammatory breast cancer. (For more on Henderson, see Saturday's FYI section.)

Iceberg said the idea for the CD came from Tony Ladesich of Pendergast.

"He knew I had all these songs sitting around recorded, and he asked me to put together a CD and sell it in connection with the benefit," Iceberg said.

The versions of the CD sold at the "[Apocalypse Meow](#)" shows will get the special-edition treatment.
